MESSAGE FROM THE PROVOST

I never thought when I started out at my local community college right out of high school (nearly 40 years ago-wow!) that those experiences would have such an impact on the work I do today. My folks worked hard but didn't have the money to send me to college so the community

college was the best fit for me. It's funny when I look back at how lucky I was to get hired in the Admissions Office as a student worker. Those ladies took care of me and made sure I got registered when I needed to, got my financial aid paperwork completed, and steered me successfully to being a college graduate. It was a great experience and it serves as a reminder of the impact we can have on students every day.

This week leads us into spring break and a time for our students to recharge before they return for the second half of the semester. We recently took our Student Senate to Des Moines for two days to participate in a legislative seminar and then Community College Day on the Hill. It was a great experience for them to learn about the political process and to meet with our legislators. All fifteen community college districts spotlighted a program and lowa Valley chose our conservation technology program. Professor EmiLee Novak shared information about the many careers in conservation technology and discussed issues like environmental quality with our legislators. We rounded out our two days in Des Moines with the Phi Theta Kappa awards banquet where we honored Jenna Hill from Zearing, lowa, and Xavian Andrews from Gaithersburg, Texas, for their outstanding achievements.

Our winter athletic teams are winding up their seasons. Wrestling sent seven men and ten women to the NJCAA national tournament. The Panthers saw Brent Greenfield earn All-American honors again this year with 6th place on the podium. Women's basketball has seen success this year and has wrapped up their season. The men's basketball team defeated lowa Lakes Community College to become 1st in Region IV NJCAA and advanced to nationals where they placed 4th! Baseball and softball have been on the road for the last few weeks with home openers right after spring break. ECC saw six of eight of our fall sports have a team grade point average above 3.00 or B. That is a testament to the student's and coaches' commitment to the classroom as well as success on the field.

Graduation is Friday, May 10 at 2:00 pm in Martin Dittmer Gymnasium. For me, it's the best day of the year with students, their families, and our faculty and staff all together to celebrate our students' achievements. So many of our graduates receive scholarships to assist them in making a college education affordable. I am grateful for the generosity of donors that, like my own experience many years ago, help to make a degree at Ellsworth within reach. We appreciate all you do to contribute to student success on our campus and hope you will join us at graduation as we celebrate another class of Ellsworth alumni!
